ORDER

It is hereby ORDERED that, effective October 1, 2021, the portion of the salary of the Official Court Reporter of the 8<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, to be paid by Hopkins County is hereby fixed at Fifty-three Thousand, Seven Hundred Three Dollars (\$53,703.00) per annum, which salary shall be paid by the Commissioners' Court of the County of Hopkins out of such funds as are, or may be, provided by law.
