

NOTICE OF ACTION TAKEN

On October 15, 2021, the Commissioners' Court of Hopkins County, Texas, met in Regular Session. During such session the court took action in response to a violation of Section 16 of the Arbala Volunteer Fire Department contract.

- 16. All fire response areas and districts shall be approved by the Hopkins County Commissioners Court based on the review and recommendation of the Hopkins County Fire Marshal. The VFD shall participate in the fire dispatch protocol within Hopkins County. Each department in Hopkins County is responsible for making first alarm responses to fire or other emergencies within their District. No department shall respond out of its District unless dispatched. If there is a deliberate violation of the fire dispatch protocol (such as self-dispatching), the VFD can be found in violation of this contract, and County funds withheld.

A motion was made, seconded and carried with a majority vote of the court toward the withholding of funds of one month for Arbala Volunteer Fire Department.

ACTION TAKEN by the Hopkins County Commissioners' Court at the regularly scheduled meeting on the 15th day of October, 2021.

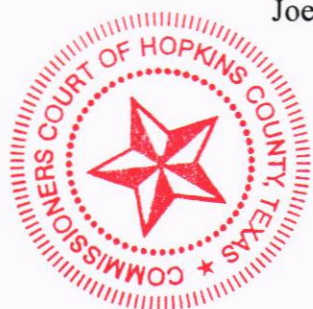
