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ORDER GRANTING DISCRETIONARY EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 262.023 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE FOR PURCHASE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY SOLD AT AN AUCTION BY A STATE LICENSED AUCTIONEER

WHEREAS, Section 262.023 of the Texas Local Government Code requires the Commissioners Court to comply with competitive bidding procedures for purchase of one or more items under a contract that will require an expenditure exceeding \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, Section 262.024(9) (A) of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the Commissioners Court to grant an exemption for "personal property sold:" "at an auction by a state licensed auctioneer"

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT FOR HOPKINS COUNTY THAT: The provisions of Texas Local Government Code §262.024(a)(3) shall apply to exempt purchases made from any auction that is executed by a state licensed auctioneer from competitive bidding procedures because it qualifies as a discretionary exemption.
