

## **DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER**

WHEREAS, Beginning Wednesday, January 17, 2024, the City of Cumby, located in the County of Hopkins has a water outage due to multiple breaks in the water lines as a result from the severe weather generating:

## Wintry Mix, Sleet, Snow, Reoccurring Precipitation, Prolonged Freezing Temperatures; and

- **WHEREAS,** The County Judge of <u>Hopkins County</u> has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and
- WHEREAS, The City of Cumby has experienced damages that have caused a collapse in the stability and continuity of private and government infrastructures due to limited or no availability of water (including but not limited to):

## Closed Schools, Fire Operations, Homes and Businesses, Government Organizations; and

**THEREFORE**, I authorize the public resources of Hopkins County and cities of this county to use all available resources to cope with this disaster; and

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY OF

**HOPKINS:** That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for The City of Cumby.
