


PROCLAMATION



WHEREAS, The Hopkins County Commissioners' Court declares September to be National Service Dog Awareness Month in support of Nola VI, Court Facility Dog Serving the Hopkins County 8th Judicial District Court; and

WHEREAS, Assistant District Attorney of the Eighth Judicial District, Jodi Cox serves as the dedicated handler for Nola; and

WHEREAS, Nola is a 2-year-old female Labrador/Golden Retriever mix; and

WHEREAS, Nola was donated to the 8th District Attorney's Office by Canine Companions International; and

WHEREAS, Canine Companions International is a nonprofit organization that enhances the lives of people with disabilities by providing task-trained service dogs to adults, children and veterans with disabilities as well as facility dogs to professionals working in healthcare, criminal justice, rehabilitation and educational settings; and

WHEREAS, Nola is a courthouse facility dog; and

WHEREAS, Nola is a professionally trained assistance dog, suitable for providing quiet companionship to vulnerable individuals in legal settings without causing any disruption of the proceedings; and

WHEREAS, Facility dogs are working dogs that are specially chosen for their calm demeanor and ability to perform duties in a high-stress environment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROBERT NEWSOM, HOPKINS COUNTY JUDGE, do hereby declare the month of September as National Service Dog Awareness Month.
