ORDER AUTHORIZING JUNETEENTH FIREWORKS SALES

WHEREAS, The Commissioners Court of <u>Hopkins</u> County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202(h), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of Juneteenth; and

WHEREAS, On the 13th day of June, 2025, the Commissioners Court of Hopkins County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of <u>Hopkins</u> County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Juneteenth period beginning June 14, 2025 and ending at midnight June 19, 2025, subject to the following restrictions:

a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, June 19, 2025, whichever is earlier.
