WHEREAS, On the 3rd day of February, 2026, the Commissioners Court of Hopkins County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order; and



- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, March 2, 2026, whichever is earlier.







ORDER AUTHORIZING SAN JACINTO DAY FIREWORKS SALES




WHEREAS, On the 3rd day of February, 2026, the Commissioners Court of Hopkins County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order; and

- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, April 21, 2026, whichever is earlier.





WHEREAS, On the 3rd day of February, 2026, the Commissioners Court of Hopkins County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order; and






WHEREAS, On the 3rd day of February, 2026, the Commissioners Court of Hopkins County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order; and



- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, June 19, 2026, whichever is earlier.


